#### YOUR PROGRAMME

If you're successful in your application, you'll start your apprenticeship in September. You'll attend university one day a week, over the course of 51 months. And when you're not studying, you'll work with our multidisciplinary design team at our King Charles Street office, developing your skills alongside our team of architects, architectural technologists and interior designers, to name a few. And at the same time, the contribution and ideas you put forward will be valued and respected.

#### **KEY FACTS**

- Level 6 apprenticeship, working towards a degree qualification in architecture Part 1 prescribed by the Architects Registration Board
- Based at King Charles Street, London, with the flexibility of hybrid working depending on business need
- Opportunity for overseas travel
- 51-month programme, with a potential full-time role at the end
- Combination of practical work and study
- Open to all ages, but you will need:
  - A minimum of five GCSEs (or equivalent e.g. O levels) including Maths and English at grades 9-4 (A\*-C)
  - A Level 3 qualification worth a minimum of 128 UCAS points, which must include an art or design subject

- A genuine interest in architecture, design and construction
- To be passionate about collaboration
- To be willing to travel overseas as part of your apprenticeship
- British citizenship, having lived in the UK for the last three years before the first day of the apprenticeship (aiming to start September 2023), and for at least five of the last ten years
- To be at least 16 years old by 30 April 2023 so you can complete Security Check (SC) clearance before your start date
- Candidates will need to undergo Security Check (SC) clearance before joining
