
As well as supporting your team to deliver designs, drawings and specifications on time, to cost and to the highest quality, you'll also help with the production of technical documentation and surveys.

KEY FACTS

- Level 6 apprenticeship, working towards a BSc (Hons) degree in Design and Construction Management
- Based at Hanslope Park, Milton Keynes, with the flexibility of hybrid working depending on business need
- Opportunity for overseas travel
- Four-year programme, with a potential full-time role at the end
- Combination of practical work and study
- Open to all ages, but you will need:
 - A minimum of five GCSEs (or equivalent e.g. O levels) including Maths and English at grades 9-4 (A*-C)
 - A construction-related Level 4 Apprenticeship;
 or a construction-related HE/HNC/HND
 qualification; or commensurate work experience

- A genuine interest in construction and the built environment
- To be organised and methodical
- To be willing to travel overseas as part of your apprenticeship
- British citizenship, having lived in the UK for the last three years before the first day of the apprenticeship (aiming to start September 2023), and for at least five of the last ten years
- To be at least 16 years old by 30 April 2023 so you can complete Security Check (SC) clearance before your start date
- Candidates will need to undergo Security Check (SC) clearance before joining, and Developed Vetting (DV) clearance after joining
