What are we looking for?

Could one of our apprenticeships be right for you? Whether you're just starting out, returning to work or changing career, our apprenticeships are open to you. Above all, it's important that you're inquisitive, proactive and with bags of initiative. Plus you'll have enthusiasm for your chosen programme and be an all-round team player.



Essential criteria for applying

Exact requirements vary depending on the apprenticeship, but you must:



Be a British citizen, who's lived in the UK for the last three years before the first day of your apprenticeship, and for at least five of the last ten years



Be at least 16 or 18 years old, depending on the programme $\,$



Have a minimum two GCSEs (or equivalent e.g. O levels) at grades 9-4 (A*-C) in Maths and English



Pass our vetting process. All apprenticeships need Security Check (SC) clearance, and some also require Developed Vetting (DV) clearance

Ready to apply?

Once you've chosen your ideal apprenticeship programme, and you're happy that you meet our requirements, you're ready to begin your application.



A note on vetting

Because of the secure nature of our work, we need to put strict security measures in place to make sure everyone who joins us is honest, reliable and trustworthy. We'll ask that you undergo an independently-run process called 'vetting' so that you can gain security clearance. Any information we gather will always be done sensitively, respectfully and, of course, confidentially.
